

NANCY COOPER SCHOLARSHIP

from Arkansas Woman's Missionary Union

Nancy Cooper served Arkansas Woman's Missionary Union as its executive director for 25 years. A scholarship fund was set up in her honor following her retirement in 1974.

Scholarships of \$1,000 each are awarded to students attending Ouachita Baptist University or Williams Baptist College and committed to a career in missions or to vocational Christian ministry. Awards are made in May for the following school year.

In the granting of scholarships, the following are required:

- a. Recipients shall be committed to a career in missions or to vocational Christian ministry. In the case of international students, they must be endorsed by a Southern Baptist missionary with either the International or North American Mission Board.
- b. Must be an active member of a Southern Baptist church in Arkansas.
- c. Must have completed one year of college.
- d. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- e. Applications shall be received before March 1 by the executive director of Arkansas WMU.

Preference shall be given to women applicants.

Consideration shall be given to Christian citizenship, financial need, and academic performance.

Scholarships shall be granted for one year. Recipients must re-apply each year.

Scholarships shall apply to tuition and shall be remitted to the school in equal installments

at the beginning of each semester, upon confirmation by student of enrollment in school.
